#### **Application Dates:**

1 September: Applications for Australian university summer vacation intakes (November – February, Sessions 1, 2 & 3)

1 April: Applications for Australian university winter vacation intakes (July – August, Sessions 4 & 5)

ACICIS reserves the right to set limits on the number of students participating in the course per intake, to assess applicant suitability for the course, and to cancel an intake of the course if student enrolment numbers are insufficient.

#### Costs

Three-week course

AUD\$1,097 tuition fee for member university students.

AUD\$1,426 tuition fee for non-member university students and private participants.

Six-week course

AUD\$1,973 tuition fee for member university students.

AUD\$2,565 tuition fee for non-member university students and private participants.

AUD\$375 administration and orientation fee: all applicants.

The administration fee is payable upon notification of acceptance into the course. The course tuition fee must be paid in full **no less than six weeks prior** to course commencement.

#### **Visa and Travel Requirements**

Participants are responsible for arranging their own travel to and from Indonesia.Participants are required to have a passport

valid for at least 12 months beyond the course commencement date.

Participants enter Indonesia on a pre-purchased 60-day Social-Cultural Visa. This is a single entry sponsored visa that is valid if presented within three months from the date of issue. The current fee for a Social-Cultural Visa is \$AUD70. Students may elect to obtain this in Perth with the assisstance of the ACICIS Secretariat (recommended) or nominate another Indonesian consultation following consultation with the Secretariat.

Participants who arrive in Indonesia with a Visa on Arrival (tourist visa) will not be permitted to commence the course.

# Academic Approval and Credit Recognition

Applicants are responsible for securing academic approval and/or credit recognition for their participation in the course from an authorised party within their home university, faculty, school, or department. It is strongly recommended that an applicant's home university approves the awarding of academic credit prior to the applicant's participation in the ACICIS Indonesian Language Short Course. For applicants from ACICIS member universities, academic credit approval should be acknowledged via the 'University Approval Form' provided on page 6 of this application package.

#### Withdrawal

Applicants who have been formally accepted into an ACICIS course who subsequently decide to withdraw from, or postpone, their participation in the course should notify the ACICIS Secretariat in writing of their intentions as soon as possible. Depending on the timing of withdrawal, different financial and academic penalties may apply.

#### Pre-course Withdrawal

The administration fee payable upon notification of acceptance into the course is **non-refundable.** Withdrawal from an ACICIS course after the payment of the course tuition fee, and prior to course commencement, will attract a withdrawal fee equivalent to 40% of the course tuition fee, with the balance of the tuition fee being refundable. After commencement of course ori-

entation in Indonesia, no refunds – partial or otherwise – will be possible. Please note that students deferring payment of their ACICIS course tuition fee through HECS-HELP will remain liable for any relevant withdrawal penalties in effect at their home university.

#### Mid-course Withdrawal

A student's ACICIS course tuition fee is nonrefundable from the date of commencement of course orientation in Indonesia Note that this date differs to the normal HECS-HELP census date in effect at students' home universities. Home institutions may elect not to withdraw the HECS-HELP liabilities pertaining to a student's participation in the ACICIS Indonesian Language **Short Course** or, alternatively, may require a student withdrawing after course commencement to repay the course tuition fee paid by the home university to ACICIS. Academic penalties incurred by a student withdrawing from the ACICIS Indonesian Language Short Course are determined by the Indonesian host university at which the student is enrolled and by the regulations in force at the student's home university. Student withdrawal from the ACICIS Indonesian Language Short Course after course commencement may result in the student being deemed to have failed the course.

### Proof of Insurance Cover

Travel insurance cover inclusive of provision for emergency medical repatriation is compulsory for all participants on the ACI-CIS Indonesian Language Short Course. Prior to departure for Indonesia, participants are required to submit to the ACICIS Secretariat proof of adequate insurance cover - including a copy of the policy wording, policy number, policy type, and insurer's 24-hour emergency contact number.

#### **Home University Responsibility**

While undertaking ACICIS Professional Practicums, participants remain bound by the rules and statutes of the home university in which they are enrolled, in accordance with Clause 18 of the ACICIS joint venture agreement to which all ACICIS member universities are party.

- 3) I acknowledge that I have informed myself of the potential risks involved in participating in an ACICIS program in Indonesia, that I comprehend the nature and extent of the risks, and that I voluntarily accept those risks.
- 4) I acknowledge that, while on an ACICIS program, I am responsible at all times for my own safety and further acknowledge that neither ACICIS nor the University of Western Australia (as the Consortium's lead institution) will be liable for any claims whatsoever resulting from my participation in its ILSC program in Indonesia.
- I accept that ACICIS in no way can accept liability for my holiday travel.
- 6) I accept that academic credit, eligibility for Austudy and liability for HECS-HELP payments will be determined by the relevant Australian authorities as applicable.
- 7) I give my permission for ACICIS to provide to my home university (if applicable) details of my academic program, progress or results.
- 8) I acknowledge that my withdrawal from the ACICIS Indonesian Language Short Course after the payment of the course tuition fee, and prior to course commencement, will attract a withdrawal penalty equivalent to 40% of the course tuition fee, with the balance of the tuition fee being refundable. I further acknowledge and accept that no refund partial or otherwise of the the ILSC tuition fee will be possible from the date of course commencement in Indonesia, and that the procedures governing withdrawal from, or non-attendance at, the ACICIS Indonesian Language Short course after this date will be in accordance with my home university's regulations covering this situation.
- 9) Without affecting clauses herein, I accept that ACICIS (and the Consortium's lead institution, the University of Western Australia) is entitled to terminate the course in Indonesia early if it reasonably determines that it is dangerous for ACICIS students to remain in Indonesia (whether owing to threat of terrorism, civil commotion, war, weather conditions, natural disasters or otherwise), or for any other reasons beyond the control of ACICIS and its constituent universities. I accept that, if the commencement of the ACICIS course is terminated after the Orientation commencement date, no refund of money will be provided for fees and costs incurred.
- 10) I accept that the University of Western Australia (as the lead institution for ACICIS and on behalf of its employees and agents) is expressly excluded from any liability

- for any loss or damage suffered or sustained by ACICIS students as a result of or in connection with any negligent act or omission on the part of the University (or its employees or agents) (including without limitation, a decision on the part of the University to suspend or early terminate or not to suspend or early terminate the ACICIS course) and for any loss or damage suffered or sustained by any student resulting from the suspension or early termination of the ACICIS course (including, without limitation, airfares, prepaid rent or other prepayments, foreign exchange losses, any loss or diminution in Austudy payments or other entitlements or allowances or any HECS-HELP liability incurred), and I release the University from any liability for any loss or damage suffered by the students as a result of the University (or any other consortium member) deciding not to credit the relevant ACICIS student with studies undertaken in Indonesia in the ACICIS course, resulting in any failure or delay in achieving a diploma, degree or other certification.

I understand that failure to comply with the above, as determined by the ACICIS Resident Director, may result in my expulsion from the course and the immediate termination of my sponsored Indonesian visa.
