### 2. Subject Description

This is a elective subject and part of group of International Law. This course designed to anticipate the integration of the Indonesian economy into regional economies, such as the ASEAN Free Trade Area (AFTA) and ASEAN +1, such as the ASEAN-China Free Trade Area, the ASEAN-Japan Free Trade Area and the global economy , such as the World Trade Organization (WTO). Students are expected to explain, analyze, practice and resolve international trade disputes. This course discusses the theoretical aspects of trade law such as the definition of international trade, the significance and forms of international trade, the regulation of international trade either through international trade contracts, national law, international law or through *lex mercatoria*. Practical aspects are also discussed in this course, such as international trade processes, dispute resolution procedures, and international trade law cases.

Subject of International Trade Law in the Study Program, Faculty of Law, Islamic University of Indonesia year 2017, given to students in the 7th (seventh) semester with 2 (two) credits. This subject has prerequisite, the students must completed Law and International Relations and ever enrolled in Commercial Law subject. 

