



For Bachelor of Nursing students only: ACICIS Public Health Study Tour: Application, Registration and Approval

Before applying, please consider the following:

- ✓ You must apply **separately** to both ACICIS and RMIT University through the respective application forms, explained in more detail below.
- ✓ You must be accepted by **both** RMIT and ACICIS to undertake the program for credit.
- ✓ You must be accepted by RMIT University to confirm academic credit and any funding eligibility (including New Colombo Plan funding).

1. Fees and Enrolment

- **ACICIS Tuition Fees:** You will be responsible for paying the Tuition Fee directly to ACICIS on or before the given deadlines.
- Please read the <u>information</u> about the costs associated with the PHST <u>very carefully</u>.
- You will enrol into <u>fee-free</u> EXTL courses at RMIT (i.e. you will <u>not</u> pay tuition fees to RMIT for your program with ACICIS). The Global Experience Office will provide you with enrolment information upon successful completion of your Mobi Application (see step 3 of the Application Process).
- You will receive credit exemption for <u>NURS1140 Primary and Community Health</u> worth 12 credits points.

2. New Colombo Plan Mobility Grant

Eligible students will receive a **\$2,500** New Colombo Plan Mobility Grant. There is no separate application for a New Colombo Plan Mobility Grant – instead, you are automatically considered for a grant when you submit your program application to ACICIS. Your eligibility will be assessed in collaboration with RMIT upon your acceptance into the program.

You must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- ✓ Current undergraduate (Bachelor or Honours Degree) student
- ✓ Studying at an ACICIS Member University (YES! RMIT is a Member University)
- ✓ Australian citizen
- ✓ Receiving credit towards your degree for participation in this program
- ✓ Have not previously received two virtual short-term New Colombo Plan Mobility Grant*
- ✓ Not *currently* a citizen or permanent resident of the Republic of Indonesia
- ✓ Not previously a citizen or permanent resident of the Republicof Indonesia

N.B. 70% of grant recipients (Australia-wide) must be between the ages of 18-28.

4. Application process

Step 1: RMIT School Approval

Seek Academic approval from your RMIT Academic area by downloading and completing a <u>study</u> <u>plan</u> and then submitting it for approval via the <u>RMIT Connect portal</u> (if you wish to seek credit for the activity)

^{*}Students are only allowed to receive <u>two virtual short-term</u> NCP grants in addition to <u>one</u> short term mobility grant and <u>one</u> semester-long in-country mobility grant from the New Colombo Plan.

Step 2: Submit your application to ACICIS Study Indonesia.

- ✓ While you are being approved, complete and submit the ACICIS <u>online application</u> for the PHST by the deadline.
- ✓ Students will be notified on the outcome of their application by ACICIS 2 weeks after the application deadline.

Step 3: Submit your registration through RMIT's Mobi

- ✓ Once you have applied to ACICIS, begin your RMIT Mobi <u>registration</u>* for the PHST.
- ✓ Your registration must include:
 - 1. Academic Approval: your RMIT Academic Area-approved study plan
 - 2. **Host acceptance:** Your ACICIS acceptance letter / Confirmation of Application email (under Question 5: Additional Supporting Documents)

NOTE: It is recommended that you commence this registration at the same time as your ACICIS application. You will need to complete this registration before you can be offered New Colombo Plan funding (if eligible). You must be receiving credit for the program to receive the funding, please see the "Program Cost" tab for more information.

*You <u>must</u> be completely registered and approved on Mobi <u>before</u> you can be awarded a New Colombo Plan Mobility Grant. <u>No</u> <u>exceptions.</u>

Step 4: Enrol in RMIT courses

✓ Once you have been accepted by ACICIS <u>and</u> RMIT, you will need to enrol in the appropriate unit(s) according to your approved study plan. Information about how to do this will be provided by the Global Experience Office upon successful completion of your Mobi Application.
