



For Bachelor of Environment and Society students only:

Before applying, please consider the following:

- ✓ Bachelor of Environment and Society students can receive credit for three of ACICIS' virtual internship programs:
 - Development Studies Professional Practicum
 - Agriculture Professional Practicum
 - Sustainable Tourism Professional Practicum
- ✓ You must apply to <u>both</u> ACICIS and RMIT University through the respective application forms, explained in detail below.
- ✓ You must <u>complete</u> your Mobi registration with RMIT University to confirm academic credit and any funding eligibility (including New Colombo Plan funding).

Fees and Enrolment

- ACICIS will invoice <u>you</u> directly for the <u>administration and tuition fee</u> these **cannot** be deferred to HECS.
- You will enrol into fee-free course codes at RMIT you will not pay tuition fees to RMIT for the program.
- Upon successful completion of the program, you will receive credit exemption for either:
 - ✓ ENVI1058 Environmental Work Practice and one 12 credit point University Elective, OR;
 - ▼ Two 12 credit point University Electives

New Colombo Plan Mobility Grant

There is <u>no separate application</u> for a \$3,000 <u>New Colombo Plan Mobility Grant</u> – instead, you are automatically considered for a grant when you submit your program application to ACICIS. Your eligibility will be assessed in collaboration with RMIT upon your acceptance into the program.







For Bachelor of Environment and Society students only:

In order to receive a grant, you must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Current undergraduate (Bachelor or Honours Degree) student
- ✓ Studying at an <u>ACICIS Member University</u> (YES! RMIT is a Member University)
- ✓ Australian citizen
- Receiving credit towards your degree for participation in this program
- √ Have not previously received <u>two virtual short-term</u> New Colombo Plan Mobility Grant*
- ✓ Not *currently* a citizen or permanent resident of the Republic of Indonesia
- ✓ Not previously a citizen or permanent resident of the Republicof Indonesia

N.B. 70% of grant recipients (Australia-wide) must be between the ages of 18-28.

^{*}these are the <u>latest</u> recommended Mobi registration deadlines. As Mobi approval is a hurdle requirement for NCP eligibility (i.e. confirmed awarding of academic credit), it is recommended to register ASAP to avoid lengthy delays in the awarding of your NCP grant.

Application process

Step 1: RMIT School Approval.

- ✓ Submit a query via the <u>RMIT Connect Portal</u> to confirm whether you are eligible to receive credit for the program.
- ✓ If eligible, complete and submit a <u>study plan</u> for approval.

Step 2: Submit your application to ACICIS Study Indonesia.



^{*}Students are only allowed to receive <u>two virtual short-term</u> NCP grants in addition to <u>one</u> short term mobility grant and <u>one</u> semester-long in-country mobility grant from the New Colombo Plan.





For Bachelor of Environment and Society students only:

- ✓ While your study plan is being approved by RMIT, complete and submit the ACICIS <u>online application</u> for your selected program by the deadline.
- ✓ Students will be notified on the outcome of their application by ACICIS one month after the application deadline.

Step 3: Submit your registration to RMIT's Mobi

- ✓ Once you have applied to ACICIS, begin your RMIT Mobi registration for your selected program.
- ✓ A comprehensive guide on Mobi is available <u>here</u>.

Step 4: Enrol in RMIT units

- ✓ Once you have been accepted by ACICIS <u>and</u> RMIT, you will need to enrol in the appropriate courses according to your approved study plan.
- ✓ Information about how to do this will be provided by the Global Experience Office upon successful completion of your Mobi Application.
