2. Eligibility

To be eligible to participate in the program:

- Be enrolled in an award program at Griffith in the trimester of application
- Have completed a minimum of 30 credit points of study towards a degree at Griffith University by the time of departure (excluding credit transferred from an external institution)
- Have a minimum cumulative Program GPA of 4.5 at the time of application

3. Tuition fees

Students will need to pay the [tuition fees](#) for the program upfront to ACICIS:

4. New Colombo Plan Mobility Grant

To be considered for the **\$3,000-\$4,000** [New Colombo Plan Mobility Grant](#), students need to apply for the program to ACICIS. There is no separate application process. ACICIS will assess student's eligibility for the grant in collaboration with Griffith University. You must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Current undergraduate (Bachelor or Honours Degree) student
- Studying at an [ACICIS Member University](#) – Yes! Griffith University is a Member University of ACICIS.
- Australian citizen
- Receiving credit towards your degree for participation in this program
- Have not previously received **two in-country** New Colombo Plan Mobility Grants
- Not *currently* a citizen or permanent resident of the Republic of Indonesia

*Students are allowed to receive **two in-country** New Colombo plan grants in addition to two virtual NCP grants

N.B. 70% of grant recipients (Australia-wide) must be between the ages of 18-28.

6. Application process

Griffith Application Process

- Once accepted into ACICIS Program, students will need to fill out a [short-term program application](#).
- If all eligibility requirements are met, students will receive the next-steps email from the Griffith Global Mobility team.

ACICIS Application Process

- Students complete the ACICIS Indonesian Language Short Course online application form at <http://www.acicis.edu.au/apply-now>
- Students submit an application indicating their choice of ACICIS program, and then receive provisional acceptance into the program from ACICIS.
- ACICIS will notify students of acceptance within one month of the ACICIS application deadline.

7. Credit Arrangements

For participation in the program, you may be able to receive 10CP (Please note, this is up to the discretion of your program director).

8. Other Possible Funding

- Griffith International Experience Incentive Scheme Grant

Griffith University's Vice Chancellor dedicates funding each year in International Experience Incentive Scheme grants to assist students with the cost of their overseas program.
