2. Subject Description

This is a required subject and part of group of General Law.

Subject of Introduction to Law in the Study Program, Faculty of Law, Islamic University of Indonesia year 2017, given to students in the 1st (first) semester with 4 (four) credits. This subject has no prerequisites. The aim of the subject is the deepening of theoretical concepts of: (1) norms, justice, and truth; and (2) the sources, foundation, principles, theories, norms, and structures of the Roman legal system, Anglo-Saxon law, and customary law. Broadly speaking, this course discusses basic Legal Studies, humanities, legal theory, and the foundations of Legal philosophy.

This course should use the methodology of active learning and contextual learning.
