## 2. Subject Description

*Ulil Albab* Islamic course is scheduled to be taken by students at the beginning or middle of the learning period with a weight of 3 credits and is a compulsory subject with no prerequisites. This course aims to develop students' ability to understand and reflect on the concept of *ulil albab* people, and to take lessons from the thoughts of Muslim scholars, the example of UII founding figures, and the development of Islamic civilization.

This course is suggested using the method of reflective learning and contextual learning. Reflective learning is a process of learning through reflection, that is, students reflect on what they have learned with the experience or situation experienced by each student. Contextual leaning is a learning process through contextualization of what is learned with real problems found in the community both locally, nationally and internationally.
