2. Subject Description

The course on practice Investigation and Prosecution in the Curriculum of the S1 Law Study Program at the Faculty of Law of the Islamic University of Indonesia is given to students of semester VI (Six) with a weight of 2 credits. This course is a compulsory subject that is taken with preconditions to pass the Criminal Procedure Code.

The course of practice Investigation and Prosecution aims to support the Learning Outcomes of graduates in the form of ability to be able to carry out investigations, preparation of reports and case files and prosecutions.

Outline of the material The course of the Investigation and Prosecution Practices covers: Understanding of the investigation, the discovery of the occurrence of *Delict*, Examination at the scene, the summon of the suspect and witness. In addition, it also discussed the concept of investigation, arrest, detention, search and seizure. The course of Investigation and Prosecution Practices also learns about pre-trial applications, how to make and compile responses to requests for Pre-trial, techniques for making indictments, responses to objections (exceptions), and prosecution and criminal prosecution (*requisitoir*).
