2. Subject Description

This is a mandatory subject and part of the group of Specific Substantive and Procedural Law. This subject is included as one of the Legal Expertise, Development, Public Service, and Thesis Courses. This course outlines the structure or organization scheme of district court, functions of head/vice of district court, duties of the board of judges, duties of registrar, its substitute secretary and bailiff. Advocacy of private cases in the district court, and carrying out a civil case. Students will also practice a civil moot court and witness an actual civil proceeding at the district court.
