Applying for short-term ACICIS program at ANU College of Arts and Social Sciences

Important:

Before applying at acicis.edu.au/apply-now, please consider the following:

1 Eligibility

A student must meet the following criteria to apply for a short-term study abroad program:

- completed at least 48 units (one full year of study) at ANU by the time the study abroad program begins;
- a GPA of 4 or above (a pass average) to the time of processing the study abroad application.

2 Tuition fees

All students will be required to pay the ACICIS tuition fees for the program directly to ACICIS.

3 New Colombo Plan Mobility Grant

To apply for the **New Colombo Plan Mobility Grant**, students need to apply for the program. ACICIS will then assess the eligibility of the grant and the student will be awarded the grant if he/she meets all of the criteria:

- The student is a current undergraduate (Bachelor or Honours Degree) student
- The student is studying at an ACICIS Member University
- The student is an Australian citizen
- The student will be receiving credit towards my degree for participation in this program
- The student has not previously received two New Colombo Plan mobility grants for in-country study*
- The student is not a citizen or permanent resident of the Republic of Indonesia

*Students can receive a maximum of two New Colombo Plan mobility grants for in-country programs over the course of their studies.

*70% of grant recipients (Australia-wide) must be between the ages of 18-28.

4 Application deadlines

5 Application process

Step 1: Register your interest with ACICIS Study Indonesia

- A. Email the Secretariat at enquiries@acicis.edu.au or call 08 6488 6675.

Step 2: Consult the Student & Education Office

- A. Download the ACICIS Professional Practica course outline, available online here: <http://www.acicis.edu.au/resources/>
- B. Visit the CASS Student Office and consult a Student Advisor to see if it fits within your degree program.
- C. If you have room in your degree, complete the online CASS Study Abroad application: <https://cass.anu.edu.au/form/cass-study-abroad-application-form>
- D. You will receive email correspondence after you submit this application if you are approved to study on an ACICIS Professional Practica.
- E. Once approved, submit your ACICIS application.

Step 3: Submit your application to ACICIS Study Indonesia

- A. Complete your [application](#) for your ACICIS Professional Practica.
- B. Students eligible to receive a New Colombo Plan grant will be considered as part of this process.
- C. Students will receive the outcome of their application within one month of the ACICIS Application closing deadline.
