## Applying for ACICIS Programs at ANU College of Health and Medicine

### 2 Eligibility

A student must meet the following criteria to apply for a short-term or semester abroad:

- completed at least 48 units (one full year of study) at ANU by the time the study abroad program begins. If you have transferred from another institution and have had credit applied to your ANU degree(s), this counts towards your 48 units;
- a GPA of 4 or above (a pass average) at the time of processing the study abroad application.

### 3 Tuition fees

All students will be required to pay the ACICIS tuition fees for the program directly to ACICIS.

### 4 New Colombo Plan Mobility Grant

There are a number of \$4,000-\$7,000 [New Colombo Plan Mobility Grants](#) available to support students on ACICIS programs. To apply for this funding, students need to apply for the program. ACICIS will then assess the eligibility of the grant and the student will be awarded the grant if he/she meets all of the criteria:

## Applying for ACICIS Programs at ANU College of Health and Medicine

- The student is a current undergraduate (Bachelor or Honours Degree) student
- The student is studying at an ACICIS Member University
- The student is an Australian citizen
- The student will be receiving credit towards my degree for participation in this program
- The student has not previously received two New Colombo Plan mobility grants for in-country study\*
- The student is not a citizen or permanent resident of the Republic of Indonesia

\*Students can receive a maximum of two New Colombo Plan mobility grants for in-country programs over the course of their studies.

\*70% of grant recipients (Australia-wide) must be between the ages of 18-28.

Agriculture Semester Program – Semester 2 (July-December)	17 March (same year)

#### Summer Programs

ACICIS Program	Application Due
Agriculture Professional Practicum/Sustainable Tourism Professional Practicum (Jan-Feb)	First Round: 3 June (year prior) Second Round: 11 August (year prior) (if places available)
Public Health Study Tour (Nov-Dec)	25 August (same year)

## 6 Application process

### Step 1: Register your interest with ACICIS Study Indonesia

### Step 2: Register your interest with the Sub Dean at the ANU College of Health and Medicine

- A. Email CHM Sub Dean [subdean.science@anu.edu.au](mailto:subdean.science@anu.edu.au)

### Step 3: Submit your application to ACICIS Study Indonesia

- A. To apply for the Public Health Study Tour, complete this [online application](#).
- B. Students eligible to receive a New Colombo Plan grant will be considered as part of this process.
- C. Students will be notified on the status of their application within one month of the application deadline.

### Step 4: Arranging Academic Credit at ANU

- A. Email CHM Sub Dean [subdean.science@anu.edu.au](mailto:subdean.science@anu.edu.au) to seek approval for your study abroad experience, and to receive enrolment details for the relevant semester.

## 7 Before you go

### Step 1: Register with ANU Global Programs

- A. ANU Global Programs requires all students undertaking an independent learning abroad experience to register with them. This system will provide you with pre-departure information and more. Register once you are accepted onto ACICIS and before you travel to Indonesia [here](#).

### Step 2: Complete the ANU Travel Approval and E-Form

- B. Seek clarification from Student Services at the ANU College of Health and Medicine regarding this process.

### Step 3: Pre-departure Information

- A. ACICIS will provide students with pre-departure information via email. Please ensure you check your emails during this period and read everything carefully.
- B. Attend an ACICIS pre-departure session that will be held by ACICIS staff on-campus.
